This publication gives a synopsis of the trading activities of St. Lucia with the rest of the world on a Quarterly basis. It also examines goods traded by broad economic category with the rest of the world.

EXPLANATORY NOTES AND DEFINITIONS

Source: The Statistics published in this report are primarily obtained from the Customs Warrants submitted to the Customs and Excise Department on the Importation and Exportation of Goods. These Warrants are coded and batched in the Trade Section of the Statistics Department before being processed by the same Department. This report is then prepared from the computer printout.

Period Covered: This report covers all documents relating to Trade brought into account during the Calendar Year, January - December, 2000 on a Quarterly basis.

Trade Classification: The classification of goods is based on the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) Revised 3 issued by the United Nations Economic and Social Council. This system of classification has been in operation from April 1991 and replaces the second Revision, which came into effect in January 1981.

System of Trade: The "Special Trade" is the system of coverage in this report i.e.

- (a) Imports represent the total of all imports cleared by the Customs for the local economy, and excludes all imports remaining under the control of the Customs Authority in Bonded Warehouses.
- (b) Exports represent the exports of all Domestic Produce and the Re-export¹ of imported goods which have previously been cleared from Customs control for the local economy. Imported goods which are re-exported directly from bonded warehouses are excluded.

Values: All values are shown in Eastern Caribbean Dollars (EC\$). Imports are valued c.i.f. , i.e. the value, insurance, freight and incidental charges up to the time of delivery at the port.

Exports are valued f.o.b., i.e. the value includes charges up to the time of delivery on board the exporting vessel or aircraft.

¹ Goods brought into the country for temporary use, with the intention to be returned or exported back to the country of origin.

ANALYSIS OF TRADE For the 3rd Quarter of 2000 Compared to 3rd Quarter 1999

IMPORTS

Total Imports for the third quarter of the year 2000 increased by approximately 25 million E.C. Dollars when compared to Total Imports for the second quarter of 2000.

In comparison to the Total Imports for the Third Quarter of 1999, an increase of 5.21 million E.C Dollars or 2.13% was realized.

For the Year to Date, January 2000 to October 2000 Total Imports recorded, was at 798.75 million E.C. Dollars, a gain of 20.07 million E.C. Dollars over the same period (January 1999 – October 1999) was realized.

The customary contribution of S.I.T.C. Section **Food and Live Animals** as the main contributor of Total Imports was surpassed by the S.I.T.C Section **Machinery & Transport Equipment** accounting for 23.6%. The other S.I.T.C. Sections which contributed significantly to the Total Imports for the 3rd Quarter of 2000 were (1) **Food and Live Animals**, (2) **Manufactured Goods Classified Chiefly by Material**, and (3) **Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles**; accounting for 19.79%, 16.32%, and 14.21% of Total Imports respectively. In comparison to the third quarter of 1999, there was significant increase in the S.I.T.C Section **Mineral Fuels, Lubricants and Related Materials**, a gain of 14.77 million E.C Dollars or 97.62%. There was also a huge deficit of 6.22 million E.C. Dollars or 24.18% in the S.I.T.C. Section **Chemical and Related Products N.E.S.** for the period under review. Year to Date Imports increased by 20.07 million E.C. Dollars or 2.58%. The dominating S.I.T.C. Sections were **Machinery and Transport Equipment**, **Food and Live Animals**, **Manufactured Goods Classified Chiefly by Material**, and, **Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles**, accounting respectively for 24.62%, 20.20%, 17.57%, and 13.48% of Total Imports.

Trinidad and Tobago consistently continues its domination of Imports from Caricom, and accounted for 65.79% of the Total Imports from Caricom Other major contributors were Barbados, St. Vincent, Grenada and Guyana. They accounted for 14.10%, 5.35%, 4.44% and 4.34% respectively. In comparison to the third quarter 1999 there was a slight decrease of 1.3 million E.C. Dollars in the Total Imports from Caricom. For the period January – October (Year to Date) there was an increase of 7.9 million E.C Dollars in the Total Imports from Caricom. Once again Trinidad and Tobago maintains its place as the principal Import contributor, with a 66.28% domination on Total Caricom Imports. And an increase of 4.61% for the comparative period.

Extra-regionally, the United States maintains its position as the chief Import contributor. The United States accounted for 46.32% of Total Extra-regional Imports for the third quarter of 2000. Other major contributors to Total Extra-regional Imports were, United Kingdom, U.S.V.I., Canada and Japan, respectively accounting for 10.94%, 6.72%, 6.70% and 5.63% of Total Extra-regional Imports for the third quarter of 2000.

The contribution of the United States to Total Exports remain significant with a 36.07 percent share; a decrease of approximately 3.78% for the third quarter 2000 compared to the corresponding period in 1999. The other major contributors to the third quarter Total Imports were Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom, U.S.V.I., Canada and Japan. These countries represented 14.55%, 8.52%, 5.23%, 5.22% and 4.38% of Total Imports for the third quarter of 2000 respectively. For the Year to Date (January – October 2000), the United States maintained a of 36.98% dominance of Total Imports. Trinidad and Tobago, United Kingdom, Japan, Canada and Barbados were the other major contributors, accounting for 14.89%, 8.52% 4.54%, 4.02%, and 2.89% of Total Imports respectively.

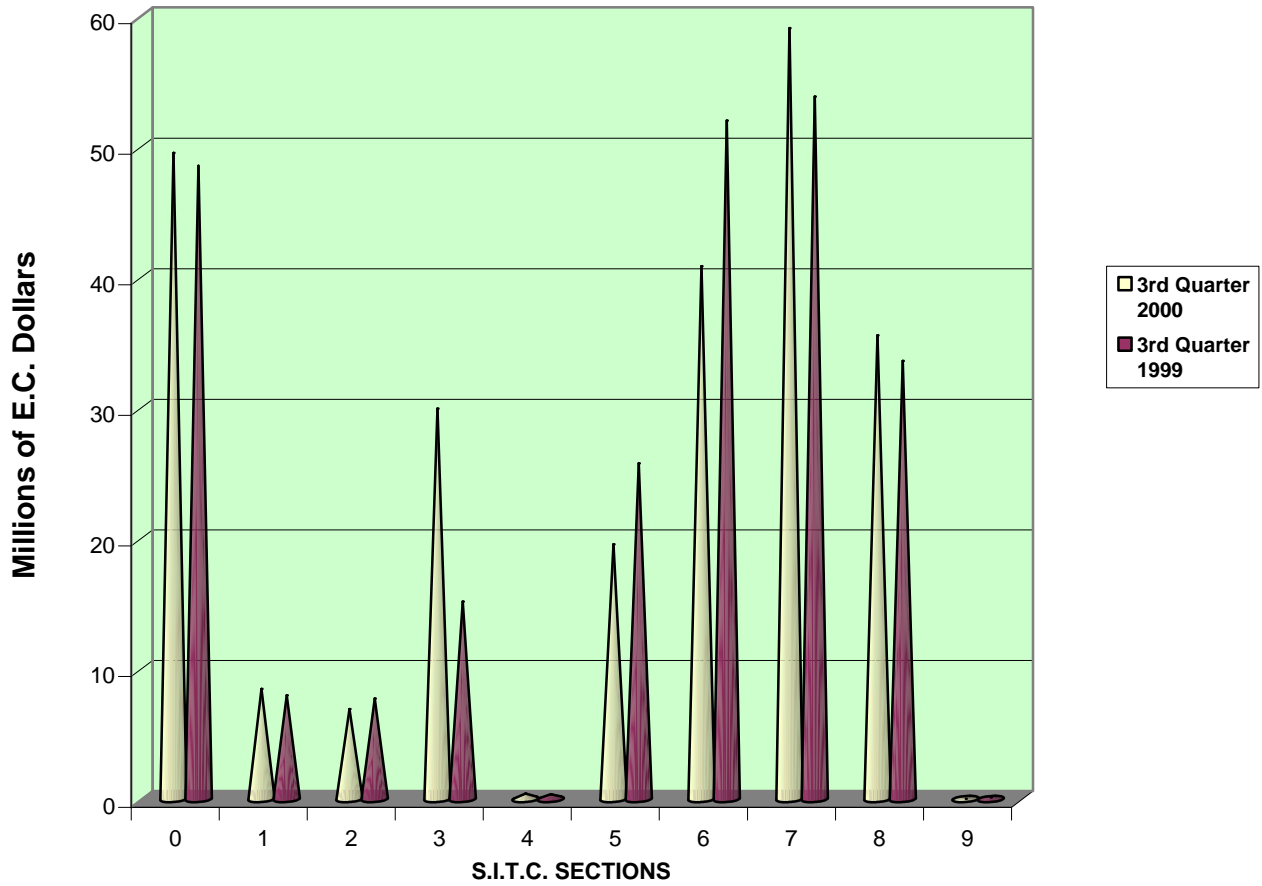

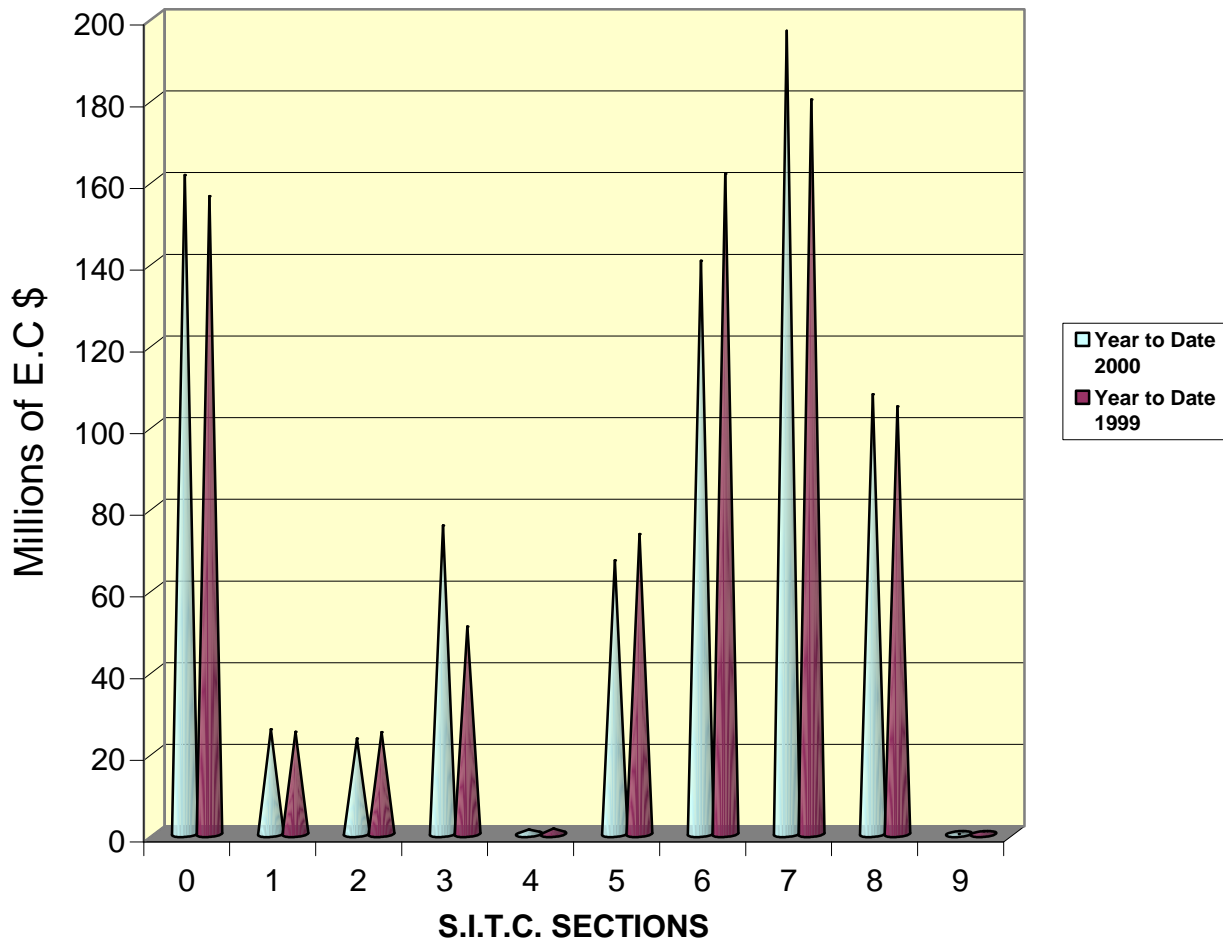

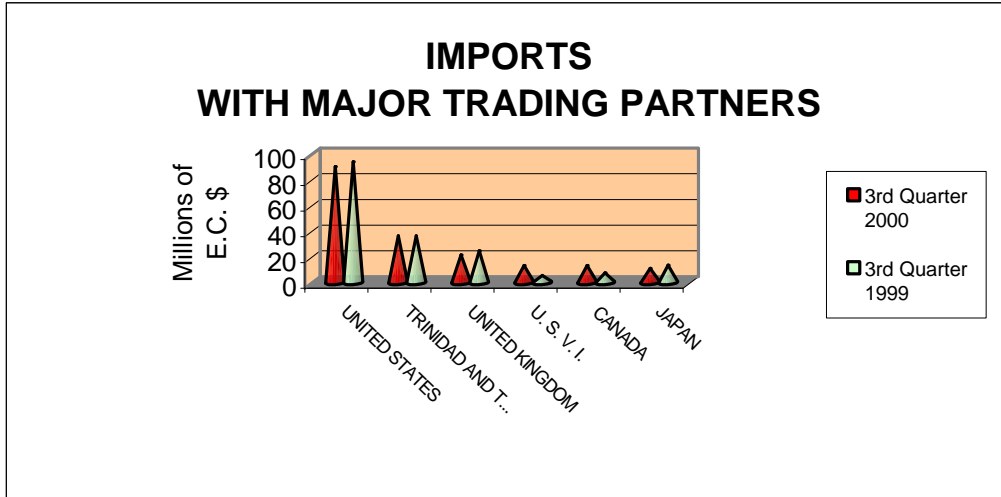
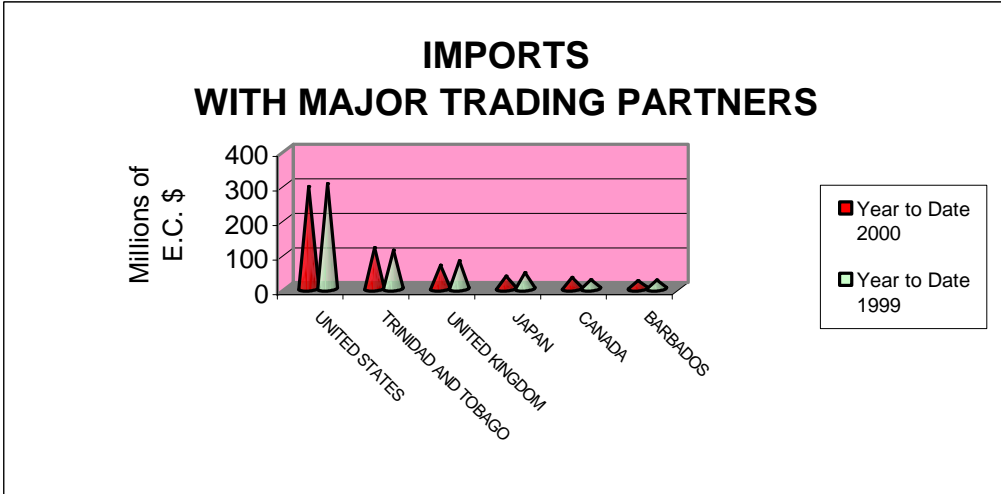

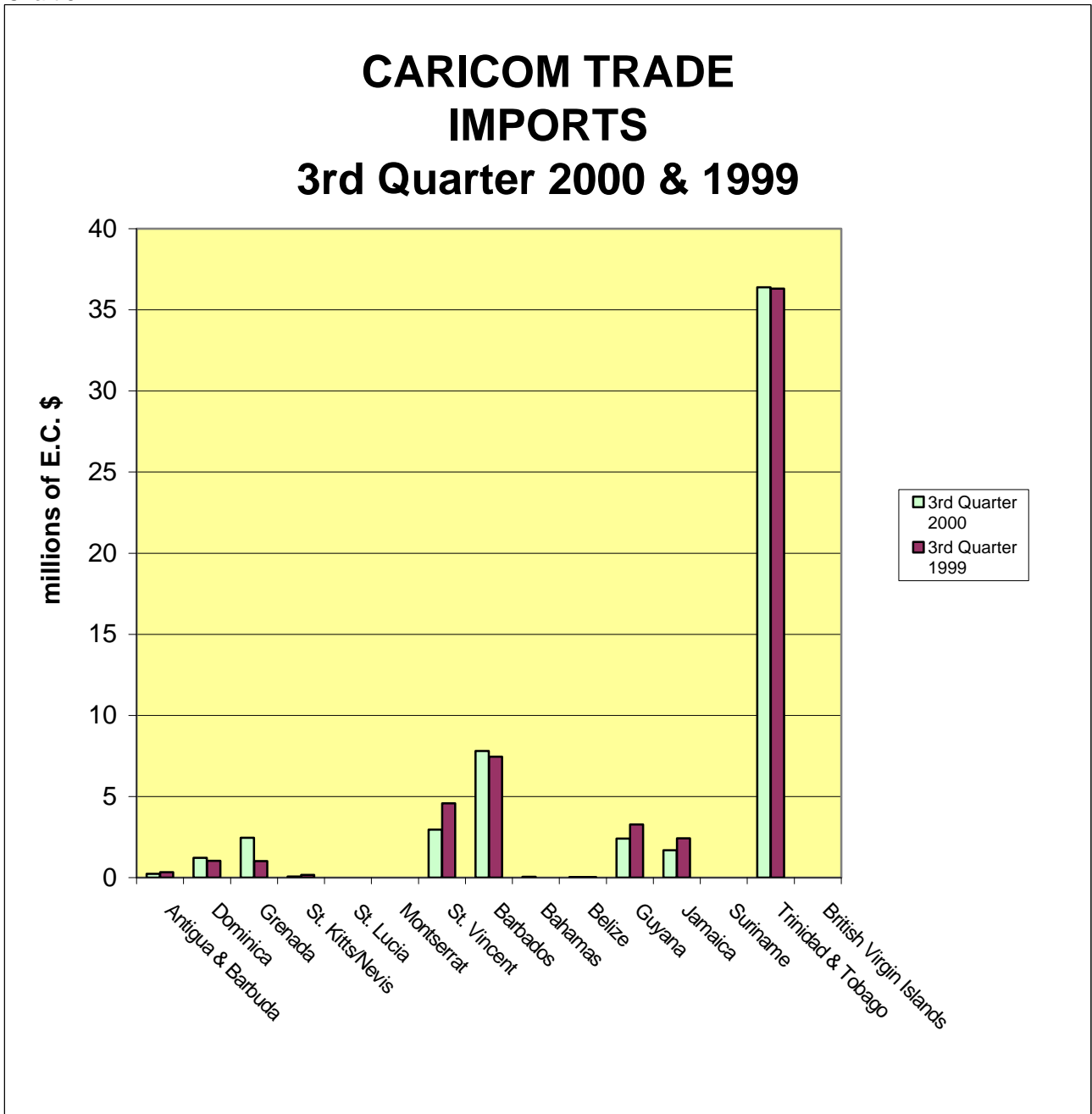

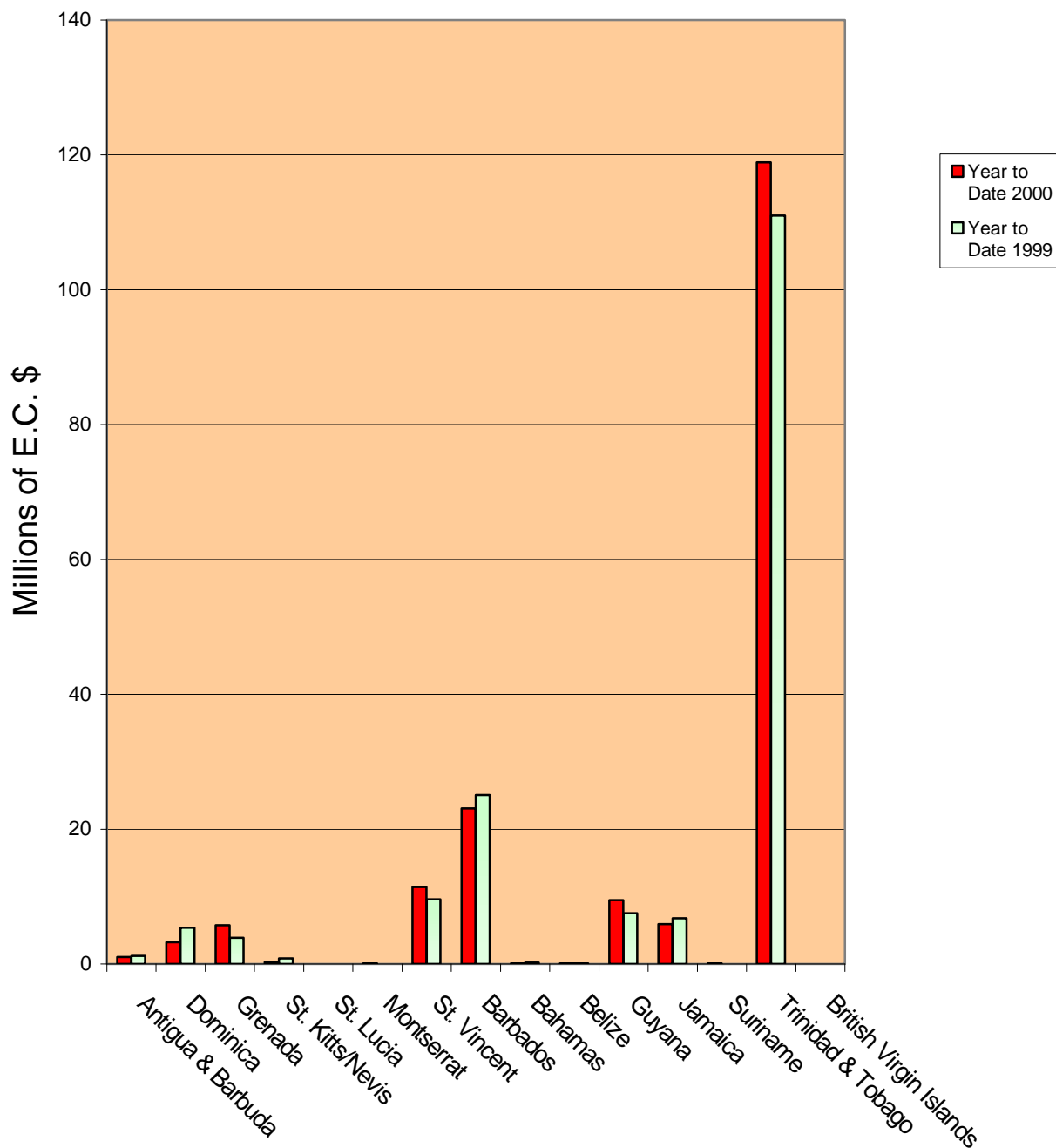

ANALYSIS OF TRADE For the 3rd Quarter of 2000 Compared to 3rd Quarter 1999

DOMESTIC EXPORTS

Domestic Exports for the third quarter of 2000 were valued at 27.72 million E.C. Dollars. This represents a substantial decrease of 7.23 million E. C. Dollars or 20.69% points when compared to Domestic Exports for the second quarter of 2000.

A decrease of 2.41 million E.C. Dollars or 8% was also realized when compared to the third quarter of 1999. Year to Date (January – October 2000) Domestic Exports were valued at 97.56 million E. C. Dollars. This reflects an 18.56% or 22.24 million E. C. Dollars decrease in Domestic Exports for the two periods under review. The continued reduction in the S. I. T. C. Section **Food and Live Animals** maintained its diminishing effect on the total value of Domestic Exports. For Year to Date (January – October 2000) when compared to Year to Date 1999 a decrease of 24.46% was realized. (Also, a decrease of 3.31% was realized in the third quarter of 2000 in the S. I. T. C. Section **Food and Live Animals** when compared to that of 1999). Marginal reductions were also seen in the S. I. T. C. Sections **Animals and Vegetable Oils, Fats and Waxes, Chemical and Related Products N. E. S., Manufactured Goods Classified chiefly by Material, and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles** for the third quarter of 2000. Increases, though not substantial were realized in the S. I. T. C. Sections **Beverages and Tobacco, Crude Material, Inedible Except Fuels and Machinery and Transport Equipment**.

Regionally, Barbados continues to be the country that receives the largest share of Domestic Exports. For the third quarter of 2000, Barbados received 41% of Domestic Exports to Caricom, an increase of 22.73% was realized over that of the third quarter of 1999. The other major Domestic Exports recipients for the third quarter of 2000 were Antigua and Barbuda, and, Grenada each receiving 16.47% and 12.27% respectively. The Domestic Exports received by Trinidad and Tobago declined by 72.64% for the period under review. Year to Date (January – October 2000) Domestic Exports to Caricom revealed a similar trend as the third quarter of 2000, recording a decrease of 64.02%.

Extra-regionally, the United Kingdom continues to be the dominant recipient of Domestic Exports accounting for 50.32% of Total Domestic Exports and, 71.87% of Total Extra-regional Domestic Exports. Although the United Kingdom continues to be the leading Domestic Exports recipient, a decline of 5.43% was realized for the comparative periods of third quarter 2000 and 1999. The other major Domestic Export recipient, The United States, received 23.85% of Extra-regional Domestic Exports.

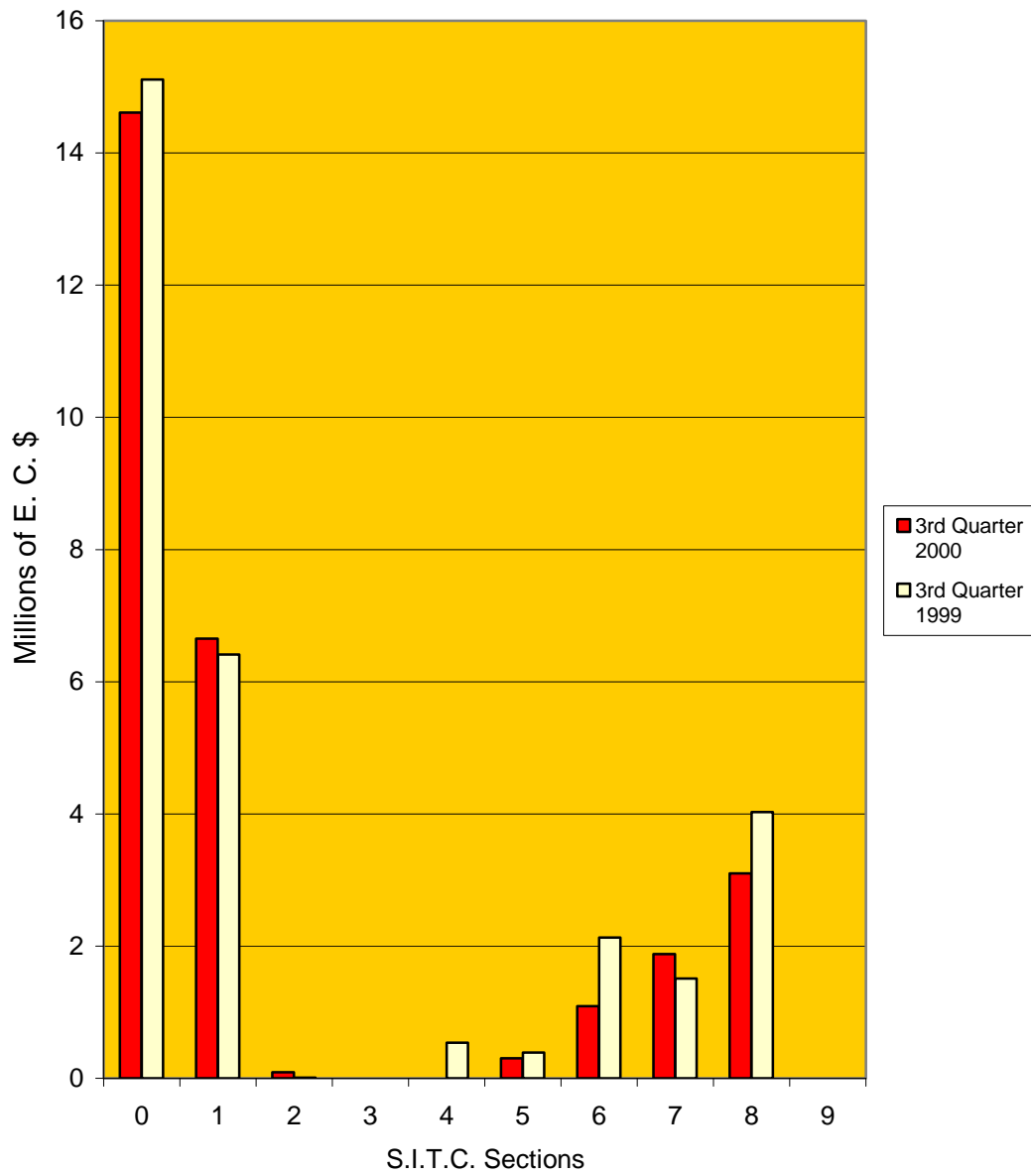

DOMESTIC EXPORTS 3rd Quarter 2000 & 1999



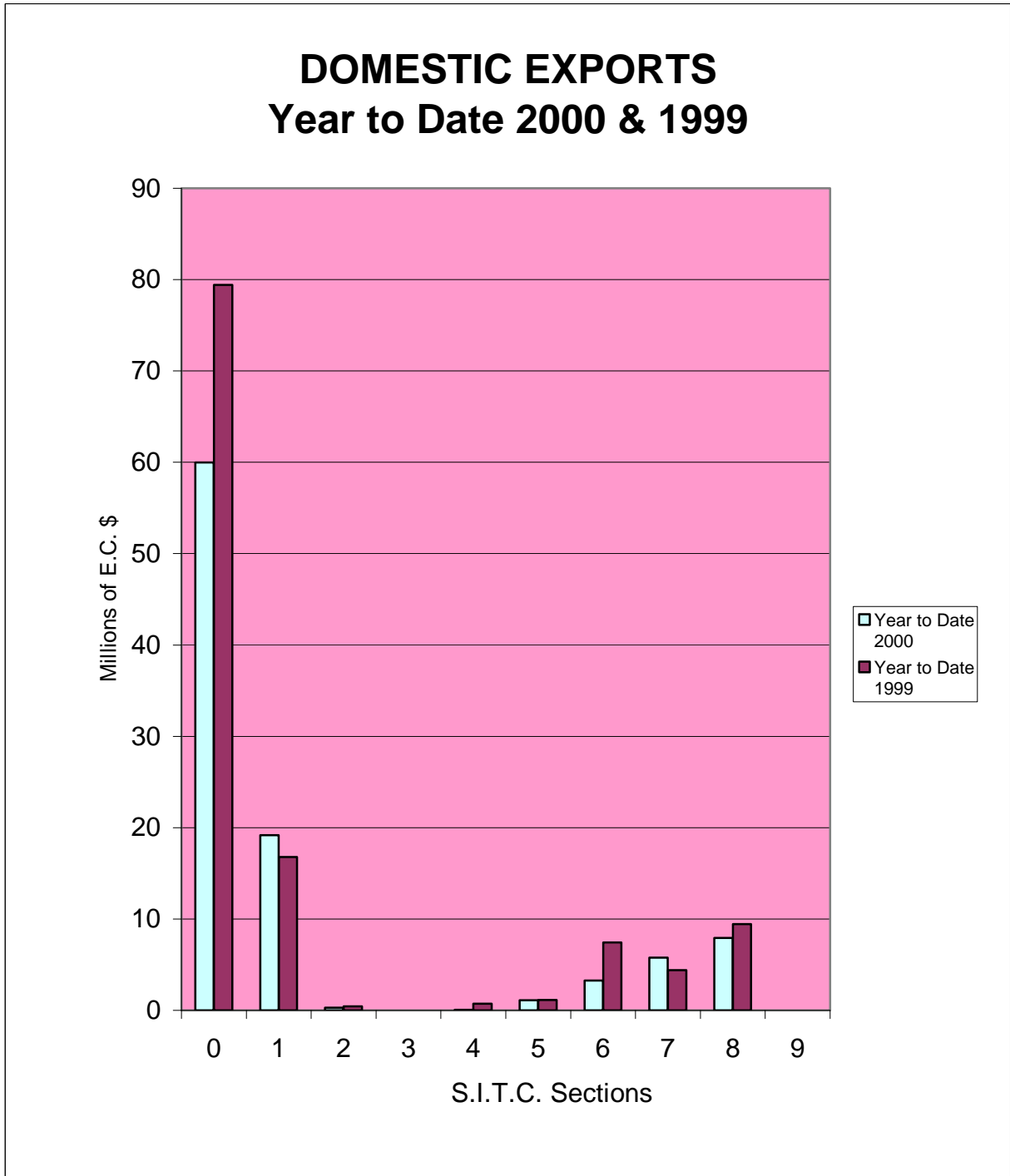

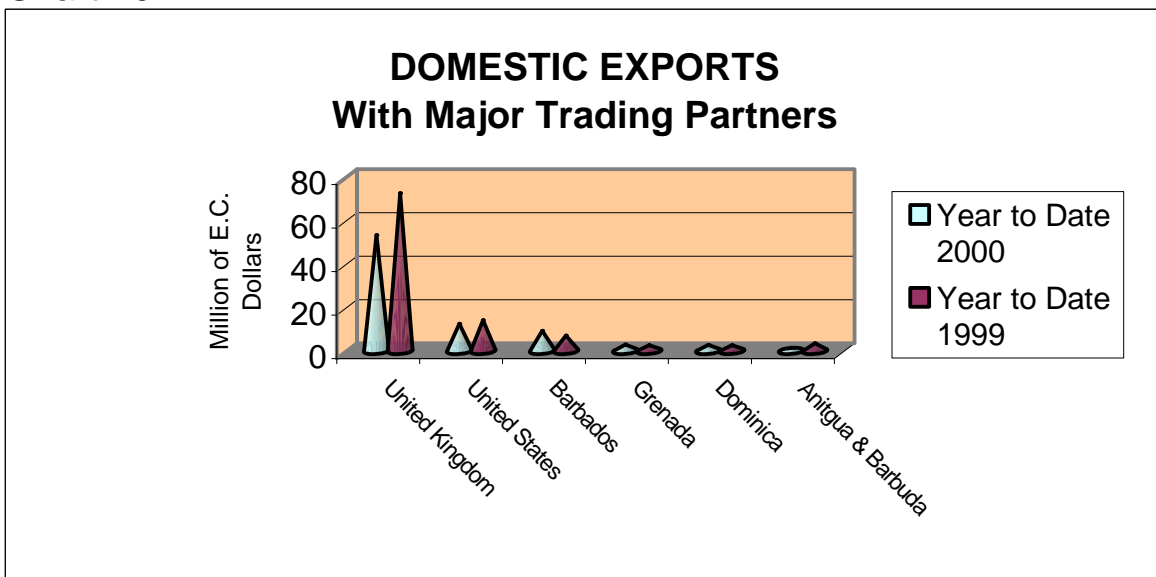

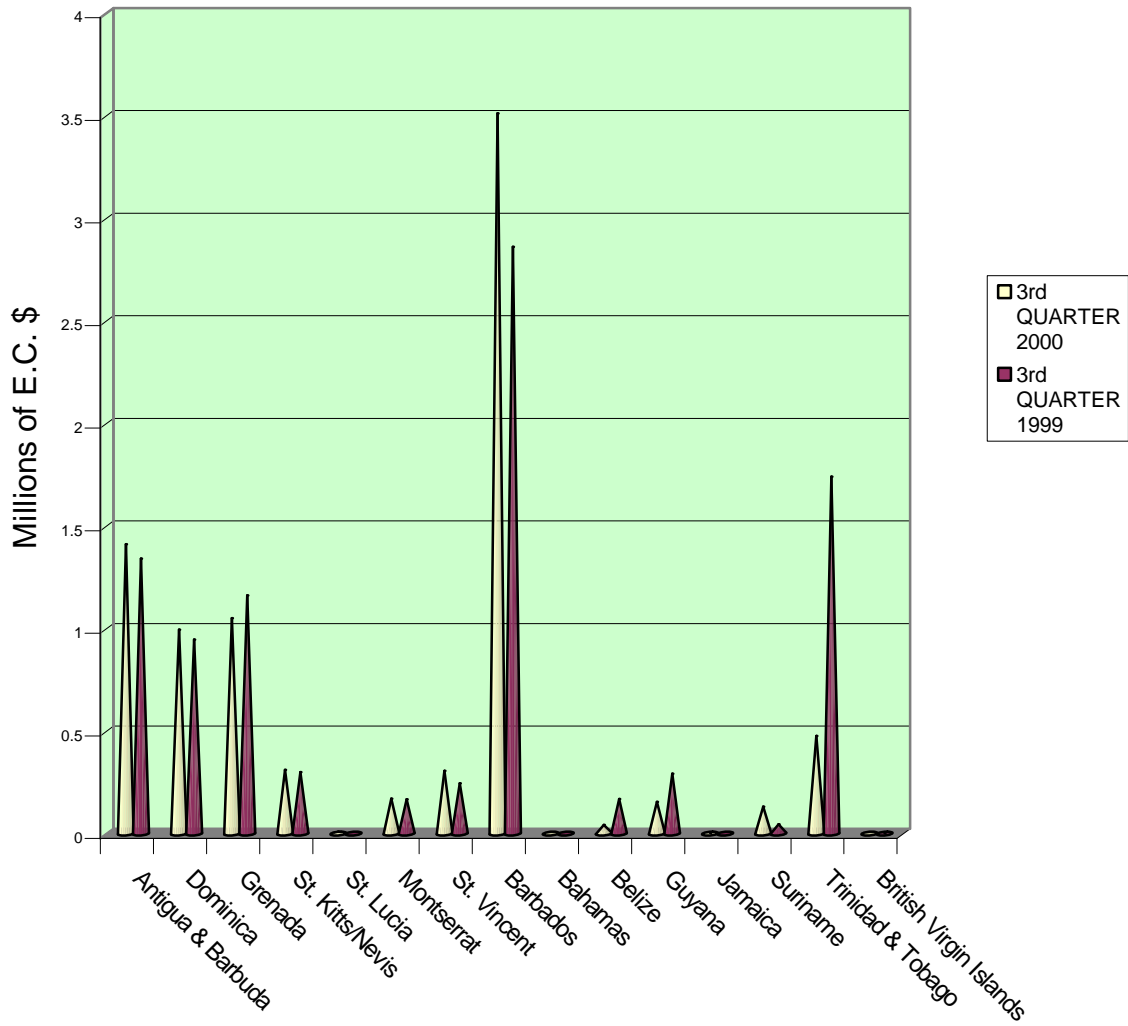

CARICOM TRADE DOMESTIC EXPORTS 3rd Quarter 2000 & 1999



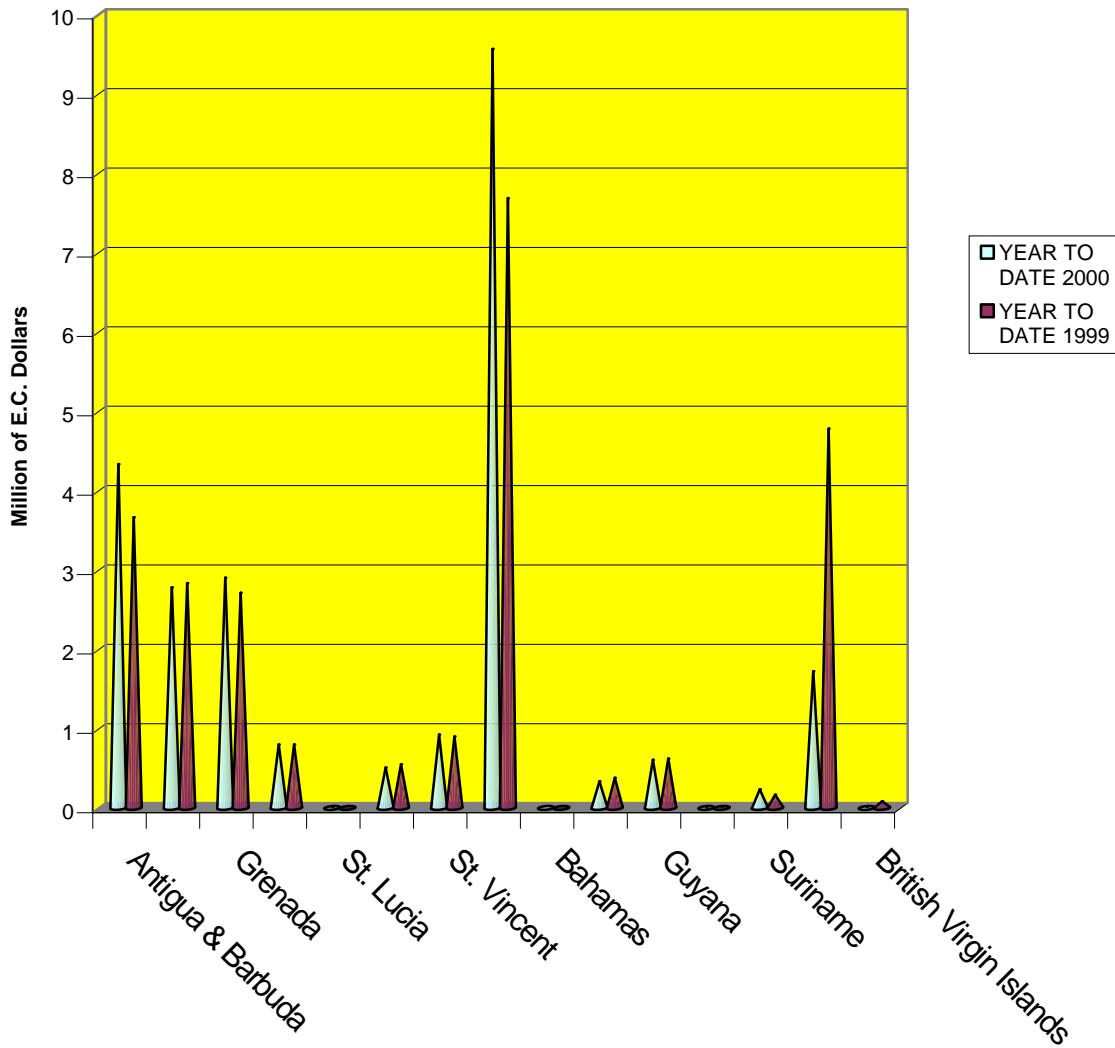
