EXPLANATORY NOTES AND DEFINITIONS

Source: The Statistics published in this report are primarily obtained from the Customs Warrants submitted to the Customs and Excise Department on the Importation and Exportation of Goods. These Warrants are coded and batched in the Trade Section of the Statistics Department before being processed by the same Department. This report is then prepared from the computer printout.

Period Covered: This report covers all documents relating to Trade brought into account during the Calendar Year, January - December, 1999 on a Quarterly basis.

Trade Classification: The classification of goods is based on the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC) Revised 3 issued by the United Nations Economic and Social Council. This system of classification has been in operation from April 1991 and replaces the second Revision, which came into effect in January 1981.

System of Trade: The "Special Trade" is the system of coverage in this report i.e.

- (a) Imports represent the total of all imports cleared by the Customs for the local economy, and excludes all imports remaining under the control of the Customs Authority in Bonded Warehouses.
- (b) Exports represent the exports of all Domestic Produce and the Re-export¹ of imported goods which have previously been cleared from Customs control for the local economy. Imported goods which are re-exported directly from bonded warehouses are excluded.

Values: All values are shown in Eastern Caribbean Dollars (EC\$). Imports are valued c.i.f. , i.e. the value, insurance, freight and incidental charges up to the time of delivery at the port.

Exports are valued f.o.b., i.e. the value includes charges up to the time of delivery on board the exporting vessel or aircraft.

¹ Goods brought into the country for temporary use, with the intention to be returned or exported back to the country of origin.

ANALYSIS OF TRADE FOR 1999 COMPARED TO 1998

IMPORTS

Subsequent to the increase experienced in the 3rd quarter of 1999 over the corresponding period in 1998, imports for the 4th quarter of 1999 maintained the growth trend, increasing by 24.51 million E.C. dollars or 10.25% over the corresponding period in 1998. Machinery and Transport Equipment was the primary contributor to total imports for the 4th quarter of 1999, accounting for 24.57% of total imports. Additional influential contributors to total imports for the 4th quarter of 1999 were Food and Live Animals, Manufactured Goods Classified Chiefly by Material and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles, respectively accounting for 19.10%, 18.61% and 15.51% of total imports for the 4th quarter of 1999. Increases were recorded in all the SITC sections apart from Food and Live Animals, Beverages and Tobacco and Crude Materials, Inedible, Except Fuels; recording decreases of 5.24%, 4.86% and 6.75% respectively over the corresponding period in 1998.

Imports for 1999 (Year to Date: January – December 1999) when compared to, imports for the corresponding period under review (January – December 1998), increased by 51.79 million E.C. dollars or 5.77%. Machinery and Transport Equipment was the principal contributor to total imports for the period 1999 accounting for 23.1% of total imports. Other noteworthy contributors to total imports for 1999 were Manufactured Goods Classified Chiefly by Material, Food and Live Animals and Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles accounting for 20.34%, 19.98% and 14.01% of total imports for 1999 respectively. Food and Live Animals and Mineral Fuels, Lubricants and Related Materials were the only SITC sections that sustained decreases in the period under review (1999).

Trinidad and Tobago's consequential contribution to total imports from Caricom remains invariable, accounting for 67.46% of total imports from Caricom for the 4th quarter of 1999. Other notable contributors of imports from Caricom were Barbados, Jamaica and St. Vincent and the Grenadines, accounting for 13.03%, 5.45% and 4.98% of total imports from Caricom for the 4th quarter of 1999. For the period 1999 (January – December) Trinidad and Tobago continues to be the principal contributor of imports from Caricom accounting for 65.22% of total imports from Caricom for 1999. Taken as a whole total imports from Caricom increased by 5.65% in the 4th quarter of 1999, and by 6.76% in the period 1999 over the corresponding period in 1998. In addition imports from Caricom accounted for 20.12% of total imports for the 4th quarter of 1999 and 21.62% of total imports for the period 1999.

Extra-regionally, the United States of America maintains its consequential contribution to total imports. The United States of America accounted for 52.94% of extra-regional imports and 42.3% of total imports for the 4th quarter of 1999. Extra-regional imports recorded an increase of 39.06 million E.C. dollars in 1999 over the corresponding period, 1998, with the United States accounting for 50.57% of total extra-regional imports for 1999. Other noteworthy contributors to total extra-regional imports for the 4th quarter of 1999 were United Kingdom, Japan and Canada respectively accounting for 13.21%, 5.52% and 4.12% of 4th quarter extra-regional imports for 1999. Similarly United Kingdom, Japan and Canada were notable contributors to total imports for 1999 accounting for 10.5%, 5.6% and 3.3% of total imports for 1999.

A most notable trend is Trinidad and Tobago's contribution to total imports for 1999, accounting for 14.1% of total imports and recording an increase of 15.81% over the corresponding period 1998.

IMPORTS 4TH QUARTER 1999 & 1998

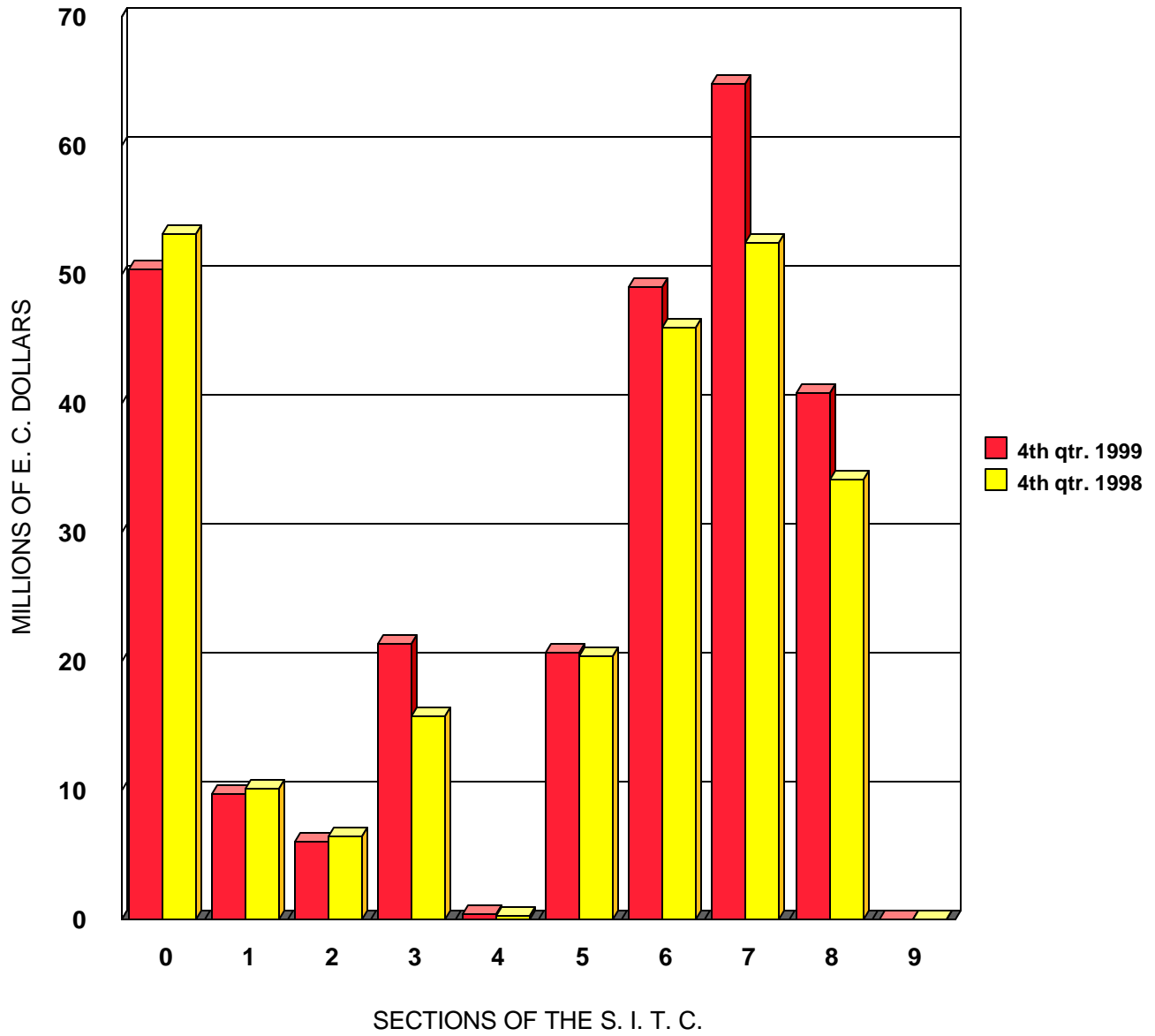

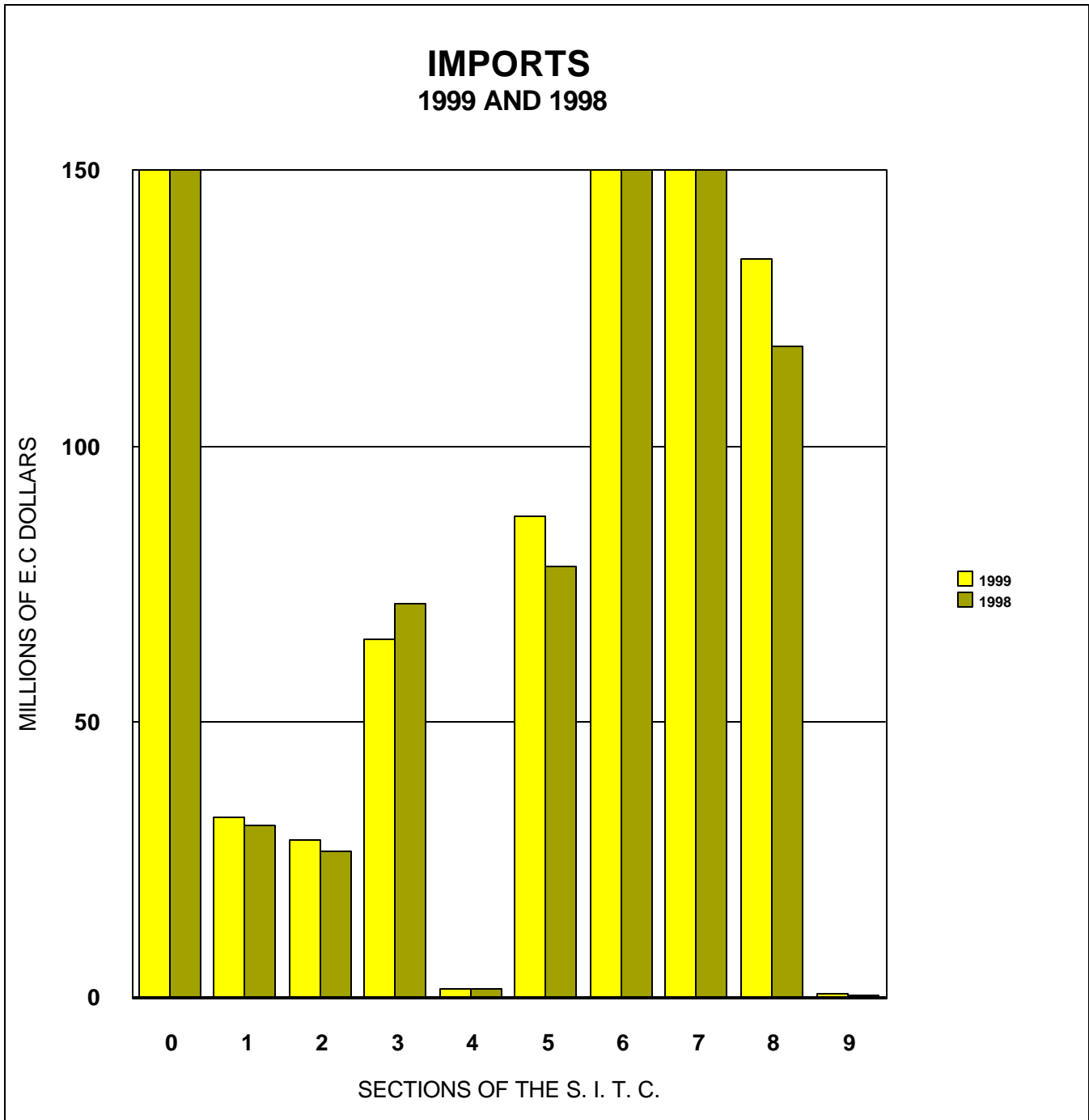

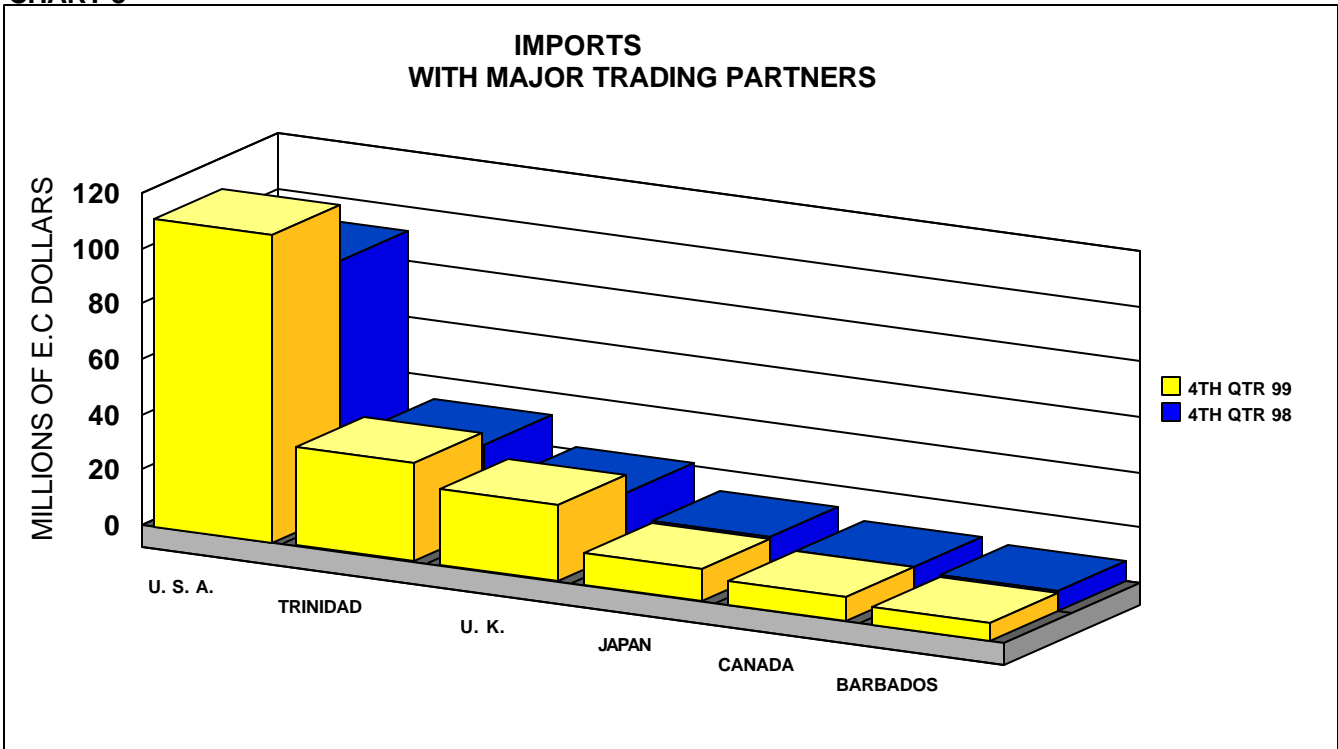

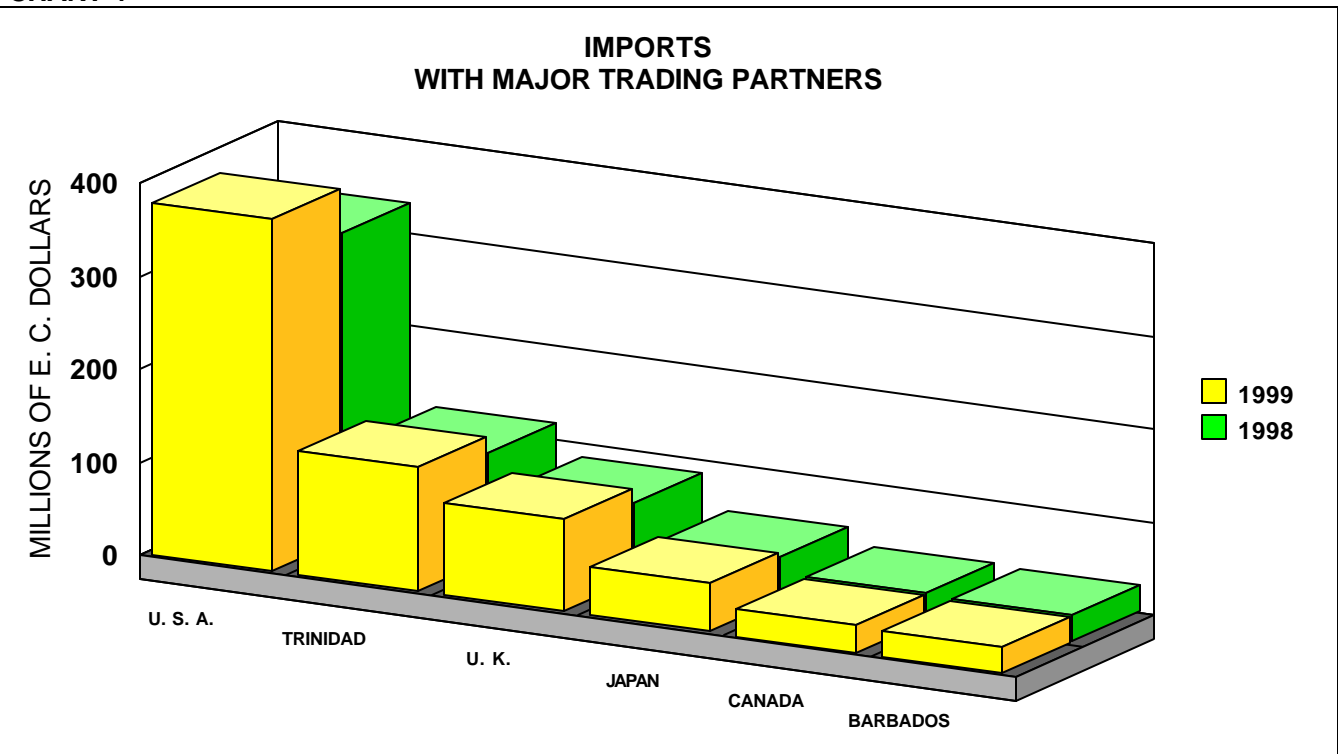

CARICOM TRADE IMPORTS 4TH QUARTER 1999 & 1998

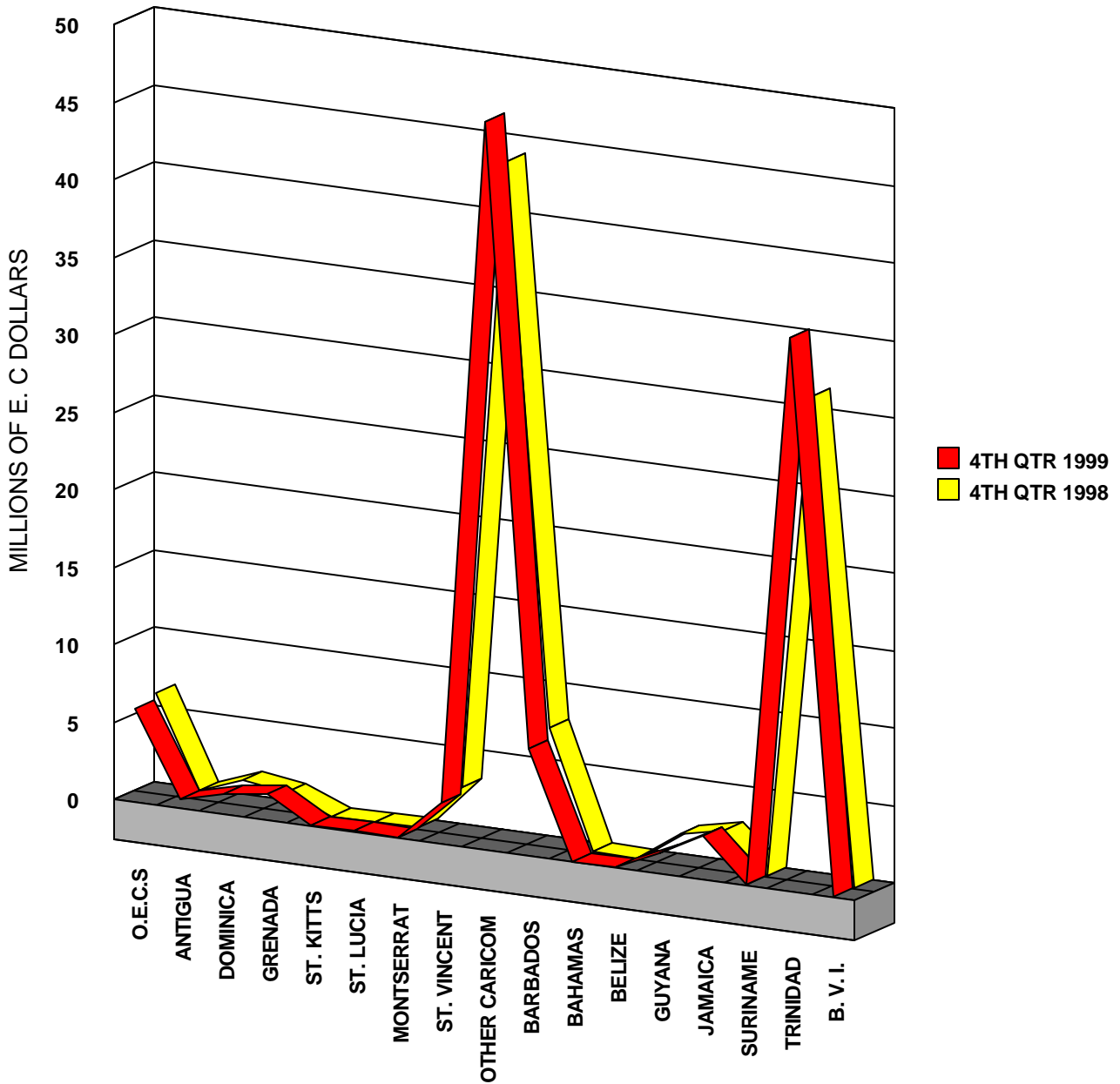
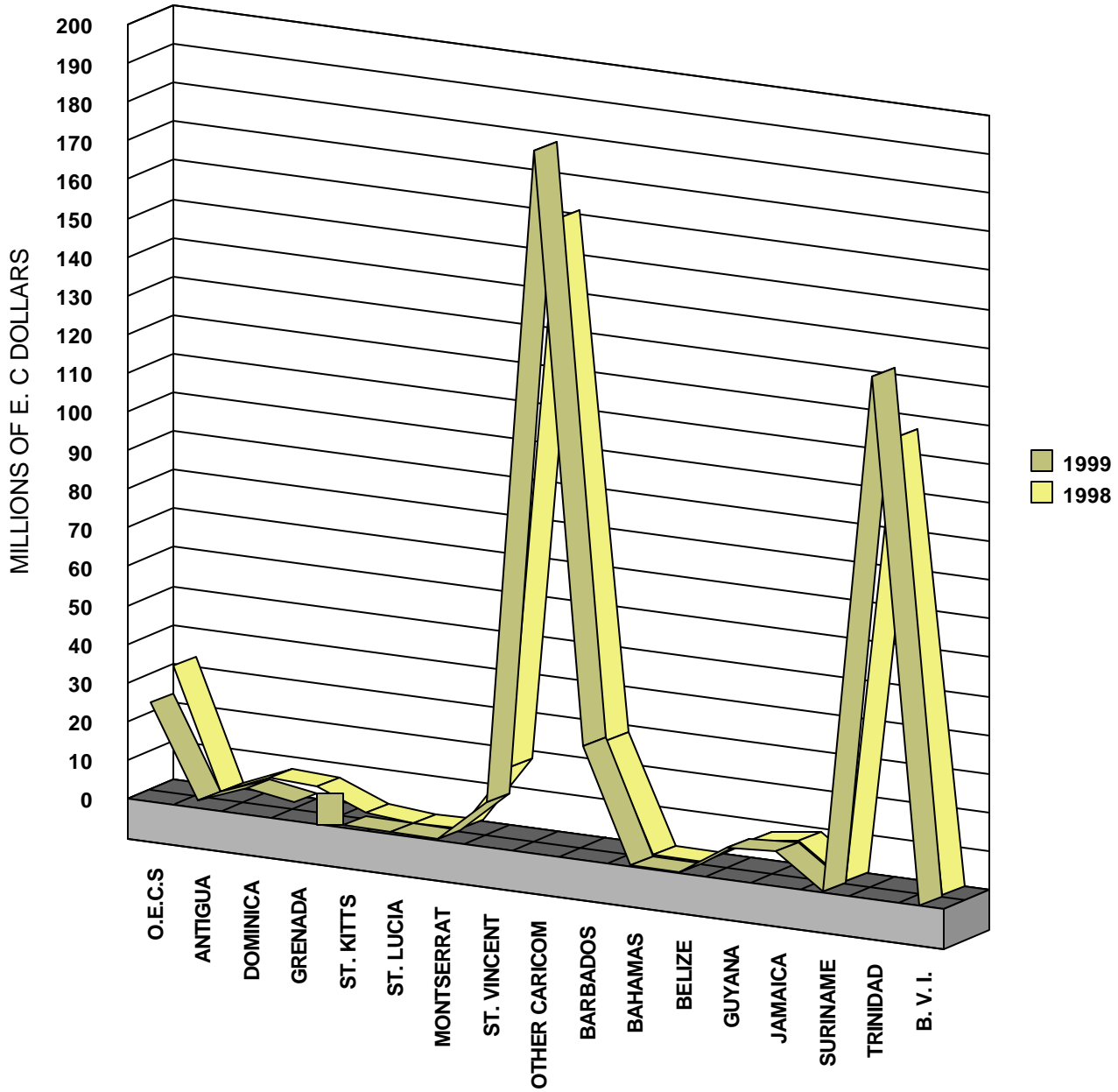

ANALYSIS OF TRADE FOR 1999 COMPARED TO 1998

DOMESTIC EXPORTS

The decrease experienced in the 3rd quarter of 1999 over the corresponding period in 1998 persisted in the 4th quarter of 1999 with a remarkable decrease of 23.65 million E.C. dollars or 46.33% over the corresponding period in 1998. This decline in the value of total domestic exports for the 4th quarter of 1999 stemmed primarily from the decline experienced in banana exports (Food and Live Animals), in addition to the fact that all the SITC sections apart from Beverages and Tobacco and Commodities & Transactions Not Classified According to Kind decreased, when compared to the corresponding period. Likewise total domestic exports for the period 1999 declined by 13.9% over the corresponding period 1998, with all SITC sections apart from Beverages and Tobacco and Commodities & Transactions Not Classified According to Kind decreasing.

The value of total exports (domestic exports plus re-exports) for the 4th quarter of 1999 fell by 43.1% and by 10.5% for 1999 over the corresponding period in 1998.

Domestic exports and total exports to Caricom decreased by 18.47% and 16.72% respectively in the 4th quarter of 1999. Contrary to the increase in imports from Trinidad and Tobago, and Trinidad and Tobago representing St. Lucia's largest import market from Caricom, domestic exports to Trinidad and Tobago decreased by 56.6% and accounted for only 12.5% of total domestic exports to Caricom for the 4th quarter of 1999. Barbados and Antigua and Barbuda were the two largest domestic export markets to Caricom, respectively accounting for 39% and 14.23% of total domestic exports to Caricom. Contrary to what was experienced in the 4th quarter of 1999, total domestic exports and total exports to Caricom for 1999 recorded modest increases of 0.55% and 1.57% respectively. Barbados was notably the largest domestic exports market within Caricom for the period 1999.

Extra-regionally domestic exports to the UK continues to be St. Lucia's most important export market, accounting for over 83.1% of total extra-regional domestic exports for the 4th quarter of 1999 and 81.7% of total extra-regional domestic exports for 1999. The United Kingdom also accounted for 63.45% of total domestic exports for 1999 and 59.22% of total exports for 1999.

DOMESTIC EXPORTS 4TH QUARTER 1999 & 1998

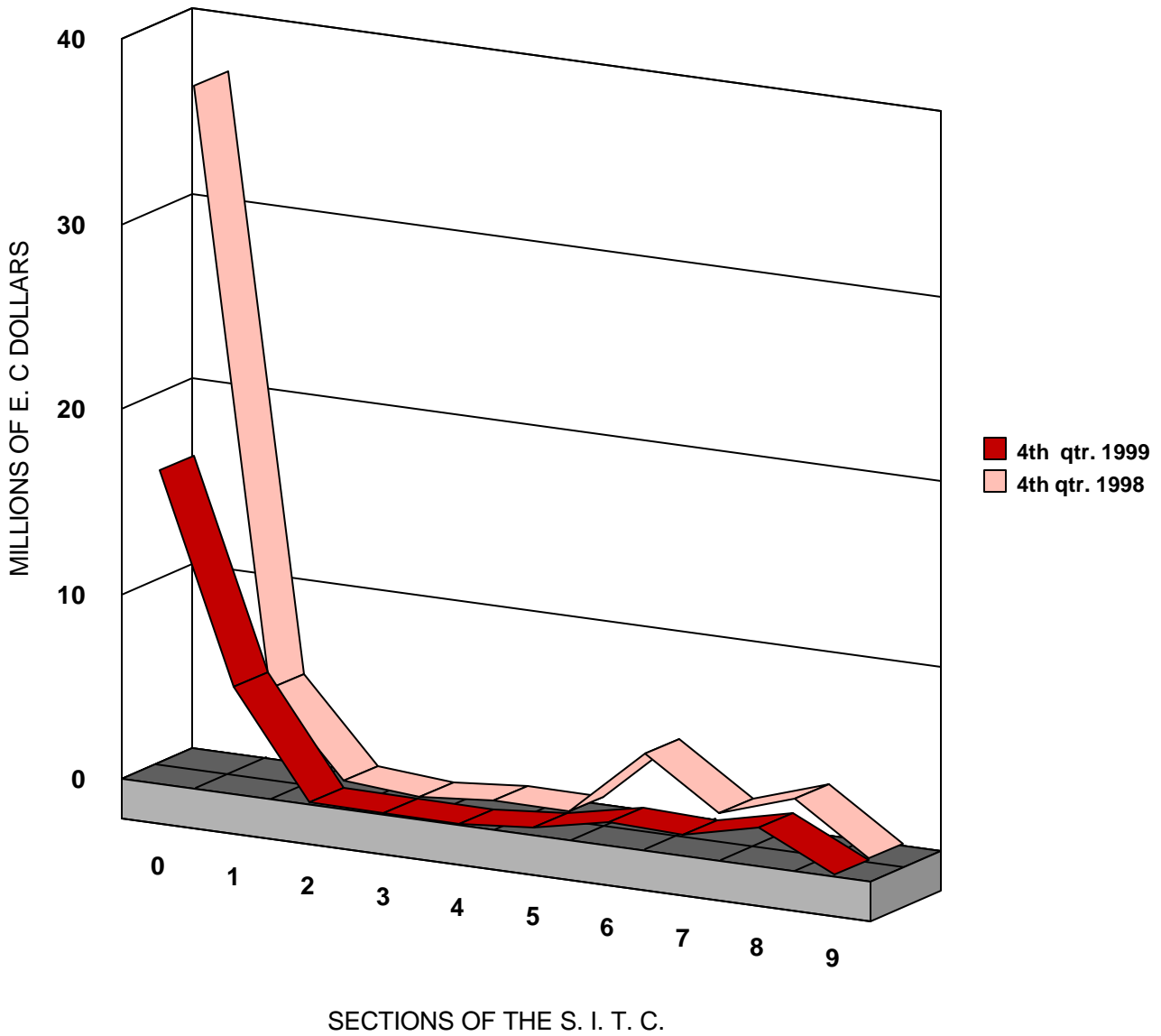
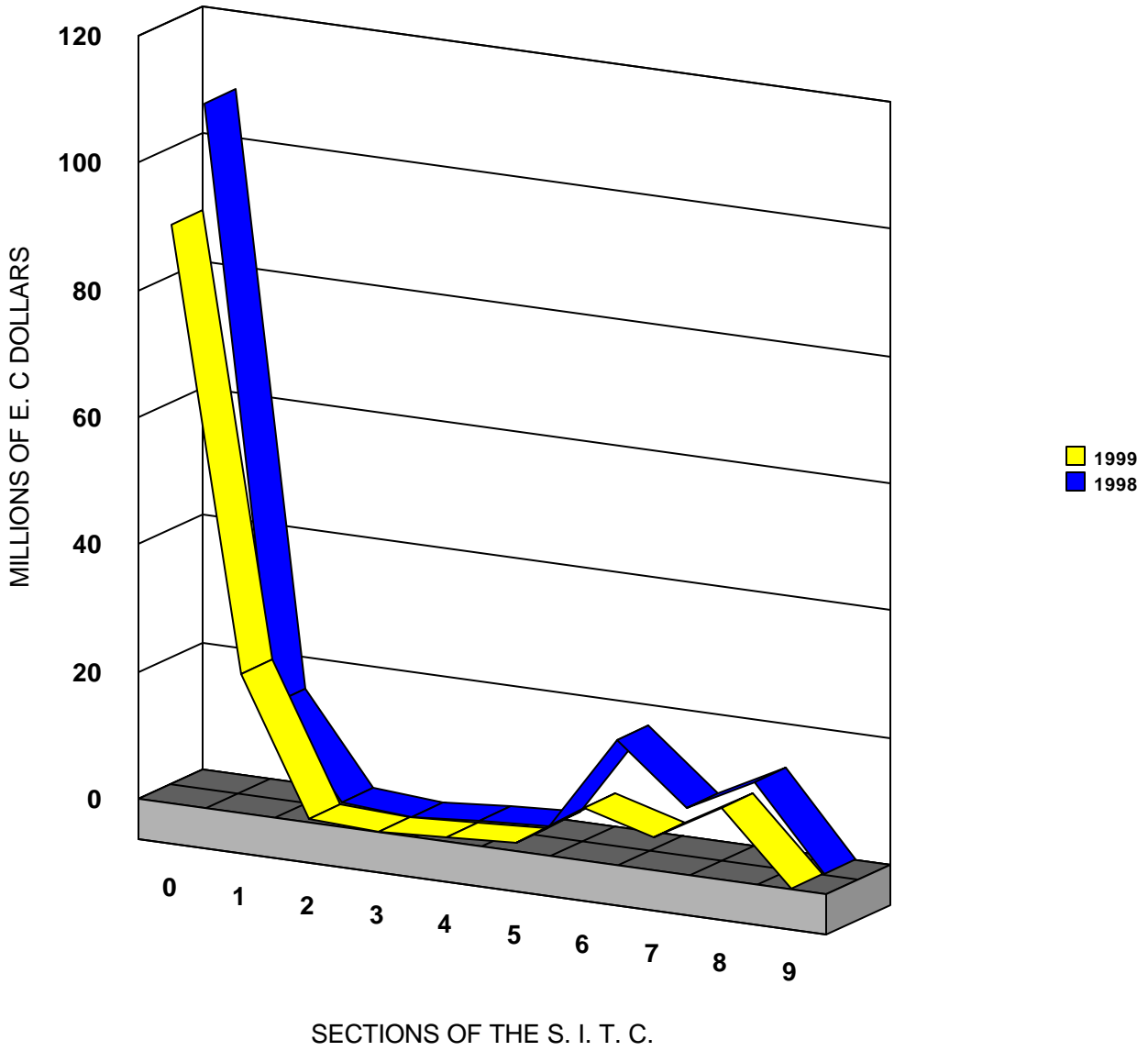
